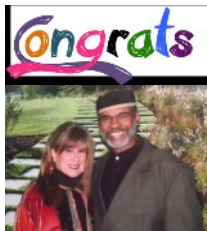

Rob is the Director of Music for the 10:15 Worship Service.

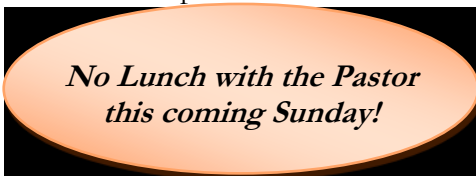
Final Crawls for 2017
