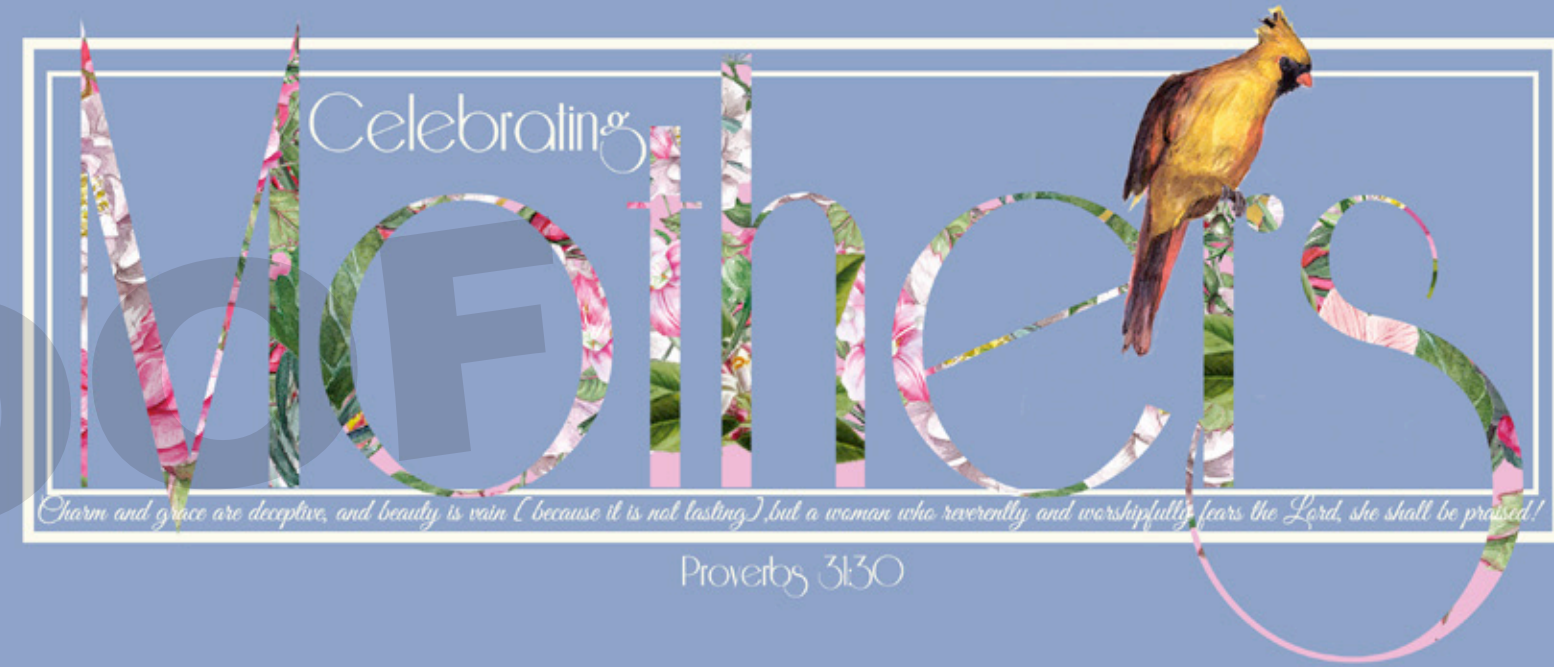

## The Year of Yes

### 2nd Quarter Prayer Directive

As we declare this the "Year of Yes", we must say "yes" to having a pure heart and pursue it with all our might.

In the times of the Tabernacle, the priest had to have everything perfect before entering the Holy Place. He could not have a wrinkle or spot on his garment. He had to be pure, his sins remitted; everything had to be just right or he died.
