



Hey guys,

Here is some info to help parents and students to get ready for SeeSalt the week of June 26-30th. We will be leaving from the church Monday, June 26th at 9:30AM. Please make sure you have all your bags and person at the church by 9:15AM so we can leave on time.

Many have asked me how much money students will need on this trip. The cost of the conference includes 10 meals, four nights of lodging, and program/materials/facilities fees, etc... However, students will need at least \$25-\$40 (will vary with choice of meals) for several meals that are not provided by Concoctions (at least 4-5meals). There will be also be opportunities for students to shop for tee shirts, DVDs, CDs, books, snacks, etc..., at the conference and during free time on Wednesday. Most students do fairly well spending money and rationing their funds: however, some students need a little help. We have several adult leaders going on this trip. If you feel like your teen may need a little help, please let me know and I will find an adult who can help your teen balance their spending.

Lodging will be in air-conditioned dorms this year. Participants will need to bring towels, washcloths, bed linens, and pillows. Beds are extra-long twin beds. Regular sized twin sheets will not fit so participants should bring XL twin sheets or a sleeping bag.

Participants will also need to pack: toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, casual clothes, shoes appropriate for active recreation, Bible, pen, spending money and good attitudes.

Please do not pack...tobacco products, shirts or clothing with inappropriate logos, ads, etc., illegal drugs, fireworks, weapons, inappropriate music (CDs, downloads, etc.), or anything else that would be considered disrespectful or inappropriate for a Christian Youth Group. (Students who violate these rules may be subject to dismissal and sent home without refund at your parent's expense).

Please note that cell phones and other music devises cannot be used by students during sessions. However, students will have access to devices during free-time. All adult chaperones will have phones and be able to contact students in the event of an emergency.
