


Phyllis Kirkland's 100th Birthday



Vestry Highlights 5/19/16

- Interim Rector's Report: A new Parish administrator, Ellen Curry, was hired. Carolyn Tapscott is helping with the transition. Bishop Scarfe will be here on June 4th and 5th. The Bishop's regional teaching is on 6/4/16 from 1-4 pm. Vestry members' attendance is required. Several Confirmations, Baptisms and Receptions will be celebrated on 6/5/16. The St. Peter's portfolio is posted on the website of the Office for Transition Ministry. Rev. Meg will be on vacation June 6-17. On 6/12/16 Rev. Bill Moorhead will supply. Between August 13-22 Meg will be on a Continuing Education trip to South Africa where she will meet with several social justice leaders including retired Archbishop Tutu. On 8/14 and 8/21 we will have a supply priest or Morning prayers. On May 29th there will be Morning Prayers.
- Wardens' Report: Lasting Beauty Landscaping will be grading the north wall along the preschool and the boy's bathroom to improve drainage. The gutters were fixed and White Roofing will do the flashing on the East wall. Larry will contact Schebler's to install the battery operated backup sump pumps with an alarm system providing notification when the backup goes on-line.
- Treasure's Report: Bruce presented the Balance sheet as of April 30th, 2016. It was accepted by the Vestry. He also presented an update on the property improvement campaign. So far 103,000.00 dollars was pledged and a little over 41,000 dollars was received already.
- New Business:
 - During the Bishop's visit he will meet with the local clergy. They will be served lunch before he starts the teaching session at 1 PM. Help will be needed to set up after the service on May 29th. East wall improvement options were discussed. Jennifer moved to have a Dryvit wall instead of siding; Laura seconded and all approved. As for the design, suggestions will be sought from the general congregation by Mike and Keith.
 - Ready, Set, Grow preschool is requesting a permanent fence be installed on the north side of the building because the State of Iowa would not approve their removable one for the license. The director offered to pay for the new fence.

Jennifer made a motion to approve the fence once the grading was completed.

Laura seconded and the motion carried.

- Summer cleanup of the downstairs will be scheduled in shifts on July 10th and 13th. The carpets will be installed in August in the Atrium and the Godly Play rooms late July or early August.
- On 4th of July suggestions were made to serve our visitors who come to watch the fireworks. Ideas were tossed around to serve snow cones or popcorn and water. Jennifer will look into the cost of renting the machines.

The next vestry meeting will be on Sunday, July 17th at 10:00 am.
