Choir (8:30 and combined services)

The choir consists of adults and high school youth, and enriches the traditional and blended worship. The choir leads the sung liturgy and hymns during the traditional worship services and offers anthems and other selected appropriate to the liturgical season. They meet weekly for rehearsals and fellowship, September through May. SATB voices blend to praise God in harmony. Prior experience is nice, but not required. Contact Joyce Buettgen, Director

Vocal Soloists and Cantors

- Vocal solo musicians may enrich any of our Sunday and seasonal services, especially for the traditional service during the summer, when the choir doesn't meet. Contact Joyce Buettgen, Director
- Cantors may lead the liturgy of evening services during Advent and Lent, or other seasonal services at the request of the Pastor and/or Choir Director.

Pianists and Instrumentalists

- Pianists and solo string, woodwind or brass instrumentalists may provide music for the traditional service during the Prelude, the Offering or Postlude, at the request of the Pastor and/or Choir Director. Rehearsals are scheduled at the convenience of the soloists. They may also participate in the contemporary services as members of one or more of the Praise Teams.
- Percussionists, keyboardists and other electronic instrumentalists, as well as acoustic instrumentalists are welcome to join one of the Praise Teams which lead the contemporary and blended services. Contact Martin Sippy, Director of Contemporary Worship

Handbell Choir (8:30 and combined services)

The Handbell Choir consists of adults and high school youth who meet weekly for rehearsal and fellowship and present Preludes and Offering Anthems for the traditional and blended services, September through mid-June. Parts are assigned to meet the experience of the ringers, and guests are welcome to come to see what rehearsals are all about. Contact Lauri Stoll, Director.

Praise Teams (11:00 and combined services)

Christ the King's contemporary and blended services are led by one of five vocal/instrumental teams: *Jesus Messiah*, *Grace Like Rain*, *One Spirit*, *Cross Walk* and the youth team *New Life*. Members gain worship planning experience, leadership opportunities and close team support through prayer and fellowship. Most rehearsals are on Tuesday evenings.
