### The Rules:

- 1) In all that you do, glorify the Lord (1 Corinthians 10:31). Whether you are at the church or hanging out at your host home, make sure your demeanor is glorifying to God.
- 2) Spend at least 5 minutes getting to know each person in the group you are unfamiliar with.
- 3) Respect the facilities where you will stay.
- 4) Respect one another, the adults, and the rules.
- 5) No obscene language.
- 6) No public displays of affection. It detracts from the weekend's purpose. #nopda
- 7) During worship and small group times, be prepared to learn and not disrupt.
- 8) Don't be stupid.
- 9) Have a daringly good time.

### Consequences of breaking the rules:

I want you to have a good time, and I don't imagine these rules will be hard to follow. However, if issues arise, whether once or multiple times, we will work through them by either assigning an adult chaperone-best-friend for the weekend who will be with you 90% of the time, calling guardians, and/or having guardians come pick you up and take you home.
