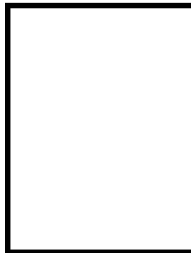

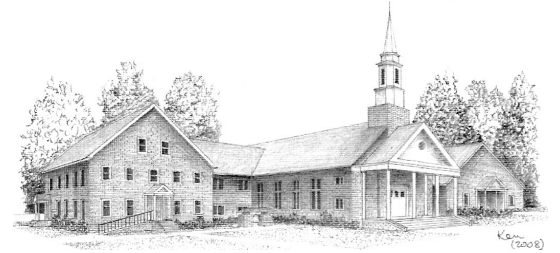

SUPPORTING PASTOR JOHN'S TURKEY-GREECE STUDY LEAVE

In our regularly scheduled business meeting on January 27, the church approved for Pastor John Tagliarini to join a tour scheduled for May at Biblically historical sites in Turkey and Greece, under the supervision of Gardner-Webb University faculty. A Gardner-Webb scholarship will provide roughly one-half the estimated tour cost, and First Baptist Church individual donations designated for the tour will be requested for up to \$2,500 of the remaining trip costs. If those designated funds fall short of \$2,500, the shortage will be drawn from cash reserves of the church.
