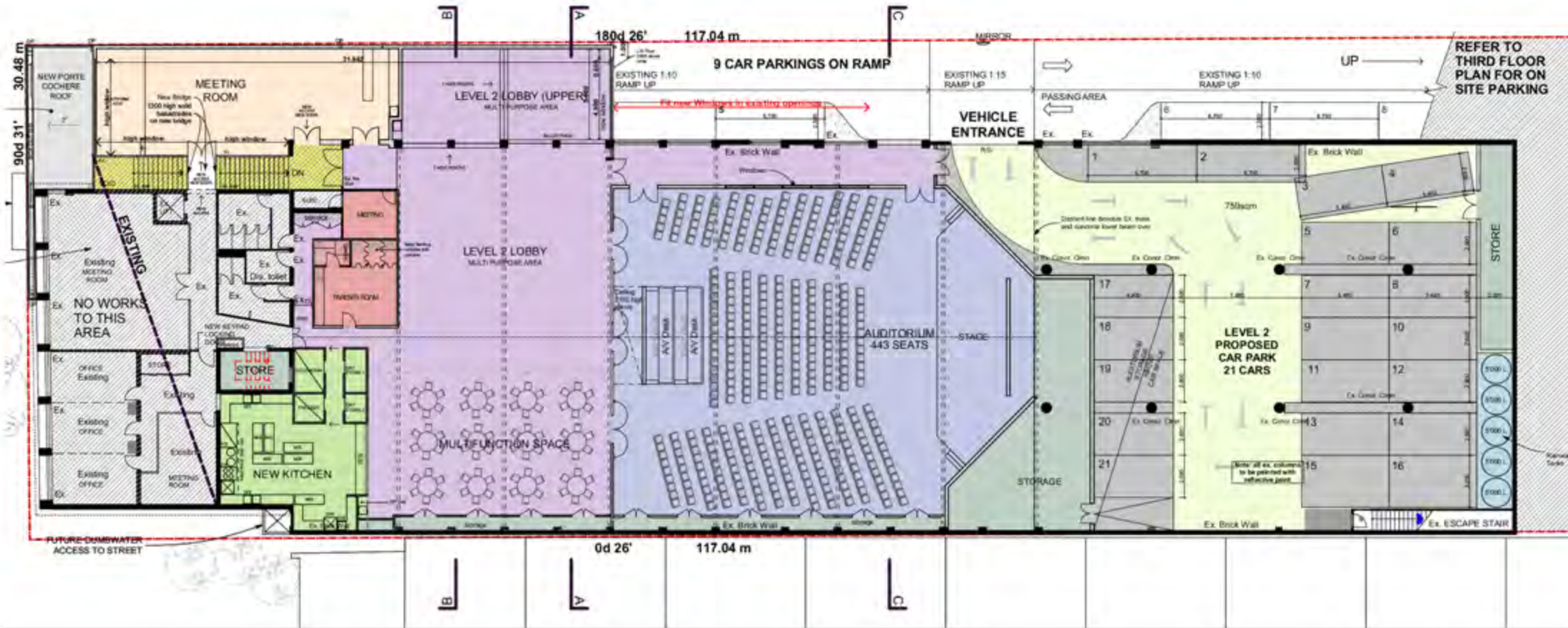
WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?

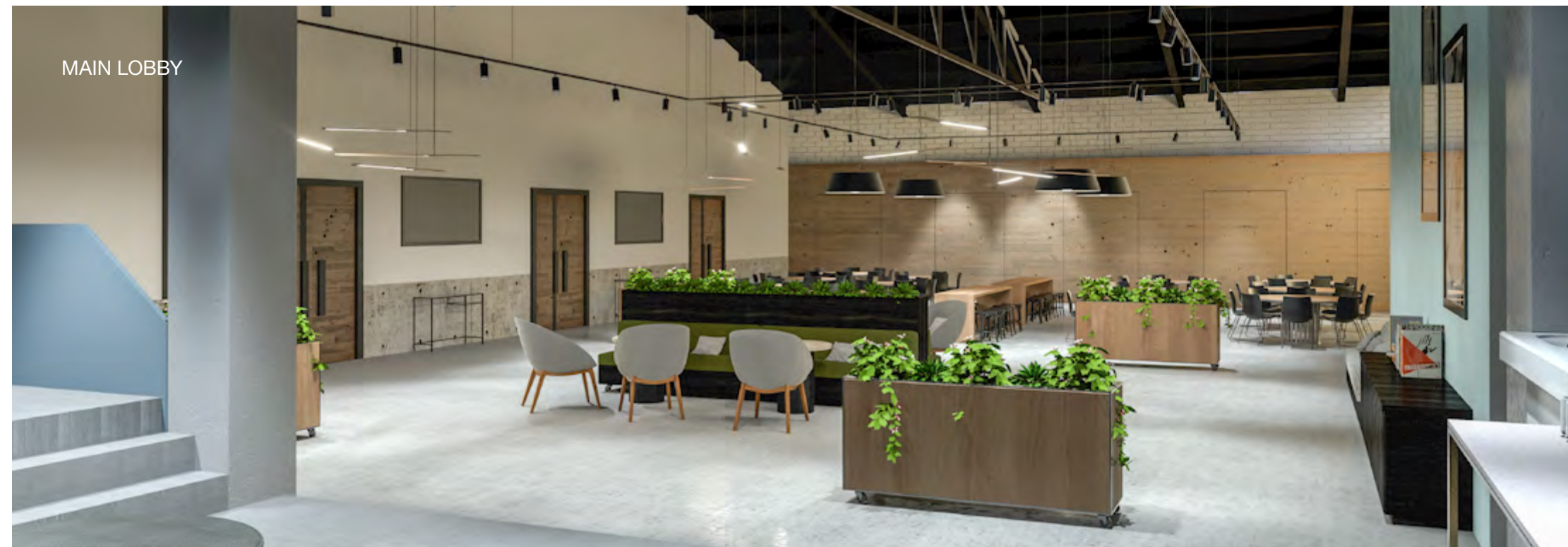
PROPOSED FLOOR PLAN - LEVEL 2

1. When will construction of the building commence?

Since receiving our building permit in September, the project manager has been sourcing quotes to proceed with early works prior to Christmas this year. This will include asbestos removal, demolition, structural steel work and re-roofing.
