#### **OCTOBER PASTOR'S COLUMN**

October brings days that get shorter and a bit cooler, the beginning migration of birds to warmer nesting grounds, beautiful colors starting to paint the leaves of trees, and for Calvary Baptist Church – the Second Annual International/National Dinner on October 28th. Last year it was a great time of food, fellowship and fun, and we expect it will be this year, as well. Of course, the event is open to everyone, so please invite your family, friends, neighbors, and others to attend!

The reason we have opportunities like the International/National Dinner is because we need the encouragement of relationships with other Christians. God designed us for connection with each other. He uses the metaphor of a human body to describe how essential it is that we unite our spiritual gifts and abilities in service for God. However, we also need the deep relationships of spiritual friendship, known as fellowship, to sustain us in the living of our days for Jesus.

John Eldredge writes, "The human heart has an infinite capacity for happiness and an unending need for love, because it is created for an infinite God who is unending love. The desperate turn is when we bring the aching abyss of our hearts to one another with the hope, the plea, 'Make me happy. Fill this ache.' And often out of love we *do* try to make one another happy, and then we wonder why it never lasts. It can't be done." It can only be accomplished through a personal relationship with Christ as Savior and Lord, which leads us into healthy relationships with each other. Once that relationship with Christ is at our core, we can allow God through us and in our hearts to fill our "infinite capacity for happiness and unending need for love." This gives us what are commonly referred to as "healthy boundaries and expectations" in relationship to others.

However, we can be encouraged in that relationship with Christ through affirming friendships with other Christians in our church family. Indeed, we all need to have trusted brothers and sisters in Christ to hearten us in the journey of the Christian life. In the military these relationships are called "Spiritual Battle Buddies." This only works when we remember that only God is perfect. The rest of us are just forgiven. Ultimately only God can fill our "infinite capacity for happiness and an unending need for love."

So, we hope all of us will strive to participate in Christian fellowship for the nurturing of our hearts and the strengthening of our faith in Christ. Indeed, as we do, we will experience Christ among us and in us!

A few changes were made to the previous By-laws, but the main changes came as we now have two bodies for ministry in carrying out the work of our Lord at Calvary Baptist Church. We have a Church Council that is made up of two components, the Trustees and the Directors of Programs. The other body of ministry is that of the Deacons. While the Church Council will coordinate the ministries of Calvary, the Deacons will be extensions of the Pastor's ministry of caring for the congregation.

Prayerfully we now are asking members to consider the open positions that have been created by the changes. Going forward, please keep all the church leadership in your prayers as they lead Calvary along with the Pastors.

Please return your completed Thanksgiving Baskets to CBC and place downstairs on the "outside counter" no **later than Monday, November 13**<sup>th.</sup> The goal for Calvary is 65 baskets!

### Please include <u>ONLY</u> the following items in each basket:

1 can sweet potatoes/yams (23-29 oz can)

- 2 cans meat/main dish (example: beef stew or chili-15-24 oz cans)
- 1 large can fruit (20-30 oz can)
- 4 cans vegetables (example: green beans, peas or corn (15 oz cans)
- 1 cranberry sauce
- 2 pkg. macaroni & cheese
- 1 box instant mashed potatoes
- 1 cake or brownie mix
- 1 bag or box of stuffing mix
- 1 lb. bag or box of rice

Please do not put money or gift cards in bags.

#### TIPS FOR PACKING

- 1. Pack large cans on bottom & lighter items on top.
- 2. If possible use a Reusable Grocery Bag OR a double brown grocery bag inserted in double plastic bag.
- 3. Mark bags as COMPLETE or INCOMPLETE
