**Tuesday Prayer:** Every Tuesday morning at 9:30 a.m. members of our church gather together for a time of focused prayer.

**Children's Ministry:** TPC offers multiple avenues for our children to be involved. On a weekly basis, our Sunday School department offers a dynamic and exciting opportunity for kids to grow and have fun while learning about Christ. Our goal is to create an environment where children are consistently exposed to the real love of Jesus.

**Rave Student Ministries:** If you are a young person between the grades of 6th and 12th, or have a child that is, then this is the ministry for you! Join the team that is building the next generation one dynamic worship experience at a time!
