What and Why: Come join us as we make Days4Girls hygiene bags, which include specially handmade items designed to assist girls in impoverished countries with handling monthly needs, so that they can attend school regularly and get a good education.

Even if you can't sew, we will need people to measure, cut, fold, iron, sew, serge and package. There is a place for everyone who would like to be involved, whether or not you can sew.

Everyone needs to bring:

- a sack lunch and an optional beverage or snack to share if you like
- a heart for girls in need and a desire to serve them

Sewing tools to bring if you have them:

- Sewing machine with bobbins
- Pins
- Serger
- Scissors
- Rotary cutting tool & mat
- Seam ripper
- Ironing board and iron
- Measuring tape or ruler

Items you may donate to include in the bags:

- Washcloths - 30 are needed (darker colors are better)
- Hotel-sized soap - 30 are needed
- Gallon Ziploc freezer bags (not the zipper kind) - 60 are needed
- Fabric and supplies for making the bags and contents have been purchased at a cost of \$14 per bag, and our goal is to complete 30 bags. Donations will be accepted to help defray these expenses.
