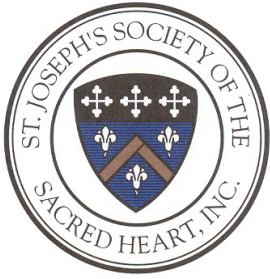

Did You Know? Evaluate playgrounds for safety. Before you let a child enjoy the playground, it is important to check the safety features of the park or playground area. Make sure children are using height-appropriate swings, slides and ladders. Equipment should be mounted on shock-absorbent materials and not hard surfaces, and children should be able to move easily between equipment. WAYS TO CULTIVATE THE REIGN OF GOD

At Home: Renew your mind. You have to be the Godly, kingdom-minded example within your home because wherever you lead, your family will follow.

Your Personal Life: Be a holy example to your friends. This won't always be easy because sometimes you'll need to remove some people from your life. You need to keep Christ-minded/kingdom-minded people in your immediate circle of friends because they have huge impact on who you become.

At Work: You are a light for Christ at work and your actions need to reflect that. That doesn't mean that you have to speak about Christianity or religion at work or force the Bible on people. However, your co-workers and supervisors should be able to see Christ in you.

In your Community: You can do so by meeting a need in the community either directly or indirectly. You can give to charity or volunteer at a community center.

At Church: You can share your time, talents and treasure as you find your place within the body of Christ. We are called to be disciples of Jesus which means that we need to bring others to Him.

En casa: renovar tu mente. Tienes que ser el ejemplo de mente sana en unión con Dios en tu hogar porque hacia donde tu conduzcas, tu familia te seguirá.

Tu vida Personal: Ser un ejemplo Santo para tus amigos. Esto no siempre será fácil porque a veces tendrás que eliminar a algunas personas de tu vida. Es necesario mantener a la gente de mentalidad Cristiana en tu círculo inmediato de amigos porque tienen enorme impacto en quien te conviertes.
