
Home Communities

What is a Home Community?

It a small group that meets regularly for the purpose of mutual edification and the application of Scripture to be lived out as an everyday community (Acts 2:42-47; Ephesians 4:11-16). The group functions as a mini-church with the leader shepherding the group to become a *family of servant missionaries* who make disciples that make disciples and multiply (Matthew 28:19-20; 1 Peter 2:9).



Questions of Application: This is a good week for men and women to divide up and talk about this awkward topic –

- 1) Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20 what is the case Paul is making for why sex is not just like exercise?
- 2) What does it mean to be "joined" together (1 Cor. 6:15-17; Gen. 2:24)
- 3) Lets talk about sex within marriage and the issue of singleness (Read 1 Cor. 7:1-5) what is this verse saying that relates to you? (use discretion about confidentiality)

ACTS of the Spirit in Corinth

^{1 Corinthians 6:9} Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹ And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

¹² "All things are lawful for me," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me," but I will not be dominated by anything. ¹³ "Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food"—and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is not meant for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. ¹⁴ And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power. ¹⁵ Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! ¹⁶ Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, "The two will become one flesh." ¹⁷ But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. ¹⁸ Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. ¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, ²⁰ for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

1 Cor. 7:1 Now concerning the matters about which you wrote: "It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman." ² But because of the temptation to sexual immorality, each man should have his own wife and each woman her own husband. ³ The husband should give to his wife her conjugal rights, and likewise the wife to her husband. ⁴ For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. ⁵ Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

Paul lays out 9 different sinful lifestyles that are totally unchristian (6:9-10)

- > They are divided into three categories:
 - 1. The Greedy (6:1-8, 10)
 - 2. The Sexually Immoral (6:9, 12-20, 7:2)
 - 3. The Idolater (6:9, 8:1-11:1)

Most Important Point (6:11): In Christ you are no longer defined by your sin *because* you have been cleansed by the Holy Spirit in Christ by GOD.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

^{2 Corinthians 5:17} Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

BI: Christians, you are called to live out of your new life in Christ.

I. The case for living by the Biblical sexual ethic

First, we need to define sexual sin according to 1 Corinthians 6 -

- 1) The general term is *porneia* = sexual immorality
 - a. Fornication (6:9, 13, 18)
 - b. Incest (5:1)
 - c. Adultery (6:9)
 - d. Homosexual sex (6:9; see also Rom. 1:26-27)
 - e. Prostitution (6:15-16)

The "Controversy" Today -

^{1 Cor. 6:9} "nor men who practice homosexuality" = μαλακοι + αρσενοκοιται

- 1) $\mu\alpha\lambda\alpha\kappa$ oi = the <u>passive</u> partner in male homosexual sex
- 2) αρσενοκοιται = the active partner in male homosexual sex
- II. Slogans misused to justify sin (6:12-14)
- III. The theological fallacy of Platonic Dualism (6:12-14)
- IV. The case for your soul AND body belonging to the Lord (6:15-17)
- V. Therefore, flee sexual sin (6:18)
- VI. Therefore, honor GOD with your body (6:19-20)
- VII. Sex within biblical marriage is beautiful and good (7:1-5)
 - "Do not deprive" = stop cheating your spouse out of what is his/hers
 - Except for prayer and by agreement = Sabbath
 - Application:
 - a. Don't demand or force sex with your wife / husband.
 - b. Don't use sex as a form of manipulation.
 - c. Don't use sex as a reward.
 - d. Don't withhold sex as a punishment.
 - e. Do not insist on or demand sex.


