RELIGIOUS EDUCATION - New Youth Faith Groups

The sessions for grades 7-12 are meeting as Youth Faith Groups rather than in religious education classrooms. Fr. Steve Varghese and Fr. Ricardo Martin have been recording opening videos for each session. After the video introduction, the youth engage in Bible study, reflection on how to apply Jesus' teachings to their own lives. Recently, they young adults have studied Jesus' teaching on the two great commandments and the Beatitudes. They then share their life experiences and plan service projects for the parishes and the community. On Sunday, October 22nd, our young adults filled 92 backpacks with school supplies for homeless students in the community. At the All Saints Mass they read the first and second readings. On November 7th, they participated in the St. Vincent de Paul meal program. **We need one more volunteer adult leader for the Youth Faith Groups.
