- 3) Explain the difference between sorrow and repentance. (2 Cor 7:10-11)
- 4) If Judas had repented could he have been forgiven? (1 John 1:9)
- 5) What was Jesus trying to do with his questions to Peter after the resurrection? (John 21:15-17)
- 6) Can you remember a time after a spiritual failure that you felt renewed in Christ?
- 7) In Jesus' questioning by the Jews, Pilate and Herod, why was He so silent? Would it have helped if He had stood up for Jesus?
- 8) Did Pilate or Herod find any reason of crucifying Jesus? Why did Pilate finally give in?
- 9) What should we remember about all these events according to 1 Peter 1:18-20?
