### **“Plan B”**

#### **Read Romans 8:28-30**

In what ways is Romans 8:28 misused and misunderstood?

Do you agree with the statement, “with God involved, Plan B could be even better than Plan A.”

Why is hitting “rock bottom” sometimes a “good” thing?
