

<p><u>Preschool</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 Full Size, Sturdy Backpack (no wheels) ● 1 Pair of Indoor Tennis Shoes <hr/> <p><u>Young Fives</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 16-24 count Crayola crayons ● 2 large or 4 small Elmers glue sticks ● 1 box washable markers (classic colors) ● 2 sturdy 2-pocket folders ● 1 pair indoor tennis shoes (preferably with white or light gray soles) ● 1 full size, sturdy backpack (no wheels) that is large enough to fit folder, snack, and snow pants. 	<p><u>Kindergarten</u></p> <p><u>Put child's first name & last initial on these items:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 pair of indoor tennis shoes to stay at school (with Velcro unless student can tie own shoes) ● Bath or beach towel for rest time ● 1 full size, sturdy backpack (no wheels) that is large enough to fit folder, lunch box, and snow pants. ● 2-3 recent pictures of your child (name on back of each) ● A 1" 3-ring binder ● 1 wide-ruled bound notebook ● 1 set of headphones that fit child (no earbuds, please) ● "Helpful Homework" interview (sent out just before school starts) <p><u>Do not put child's name on these items:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 box of 20+ count crayons ● A pair of scissors ● 10-16 No. 2 sharpened pencils ● 6-10 glue sticks ● 1 package 8-16 Classic Color markers ● One old sock to use as white board eraser ● 2 pink erasers 	<p><u>1st Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One package of #2 pencils (sharpened) ● A box of crayons (24 count) ● A box of colored pencils ● A sturdy pencil box ● 2 bottles of glue ● 8 small or 4 large glue sticks (Not Rose Art brand) ● A pair of scissors ● A backpack ● 8 classic color markers ● One pair of shoes to stay at school for PE/indoor shoes and one pair of "outdoor shoes" ● Headphones that fit your child -no earbuds please (to be kept at school) ● Boys - A box of Kleenex and 2 containers of Clorox wet wipes ● Girls: 3 rolls of paper towels. 	<p><u>2nd Grade & 2nd/3rd Grade Split</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Twenty #2 pencils (sharpened) ● A box of crayons (24 count or more) ● Small box of colored pencils ● A sturdy folder to transport papers back and forth to school ● A sturdy pencil box ● Two large pink erasers ● Four glue sticks ● A backpack ● 8-pack classic color markers ● A pair of scissors (age appropriate) ● One pair of shoes to stay at school for PE/indoor shoes. Each child must have a pair of "outdoor shoes" also ● A set of headphones (in large ziploc bag) that fit your child (to be kept at school for computer class)
<p><u>3rd Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 box of washable markers (with thin tip) ● 1 box of colored pencils ● 24 - No.2 sharpened pencils with erasers ● 1 large pair metal pointed scissors ● 2 large glue sticks (or 4 small sticks) ● 2 sturdy pocket folders ● 1 spiral notebook ● 2 pink pearl erasers ● 1 pencil box or bag ● 1 - 1" binder ● 15 clear protector pages ● 2 red correcting pens ● One plastic folder to go back and forth from school to home ● One old sock for white board eraser ● 1 set of headphones or earbuds ● 1 set of multiplication and division flash cards (to stay/use at home) ● One pair of indoor tennis shoes ● Wish List but not required: ● 1 large box of tissues (if last name begins with A-E) ● 1 bottle of sanitizer (if last name begins with F-M) ● 1 box of small Ziploc bags (if last name begins with N-R) ● 1 bag of candy for store (if last name begins with S-Z) 	<p><u>4th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 6 pocket folders (solid colored – red, yellow, blue, green, purple and orange) ● 1 plastic folder to go back and forth from school to home ● 1 folder of student's choice ● 1 composition notebook (9.5"x7.5") ● 1 pkg. of wide ruled notebook paper ● 24 -No. 2 pencils ● 2 glues sticks (prefer Elmers brand) ● Pencil box ● 1 set of earbuds for computer/ipad use (to keep at school) ● TI-15 or TI-30 solar calculator (Texas Instruments) ● Inside shoes (white or light gray soles preferred) ● Markers (optional if your child enjoys using them to color) 	<p><u>5th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Trapper Keeper-style binder (with zipper) ● Pencil pouch to fit inside Trapper Keeper ● 1 24+ count package of #2 Pencils ● 2 or 3 red pens ● Washable Crayola markers ● Pocket folders (6) with holes (different colors and/or designs) ● 1 set of personal earbuds to keep at school ● TI-15 or TI-30 (Texas Instruments) SOLAR calculator ● Inside shoes and gym shoes ● Backpack <p><i>Optional if you are able:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Crayons and/or colored pencils ● Scotch tape ● Glue sticks ● Pens ● Scissors ● Protractor and compass ● Extra erasers ● Small pencil box to fit in desk for supplies 	<p><u>Middle School</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 3" Binder used for all subjects for all 3 middle school years (see below for color) <li style="padding-left: 40px;">Class of 2018: Blue <li style="padding-left: 40px;">Class of 2019: Green <li style="padding-left: 40px;">Class of 2020: Orange or Red ● Dividers – recommend plastic instead of paper ● Scissors, markers, and pens (red and blue), and MANY #2 pencils ● A set of earbuds that fit your child and be kept at school ● Loose leaf paper (college ruled) ● P.E. shoes that do not have black soles ● P.E. shorts and shirt that meet dress code ● NIV Bible – the one given to students in 3rd grade or when they enrolled ● TI-30XIIS solar scientific calculator – from 4th grade, current calculators are kept at school. ● No flash drives ● Sports physicals required before participation in sports; must be completed after April 15 of prior year
