<p><b><u>Young Fives</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 16-24 count Crayola crayons</li> <li>● 2 large or 4 small Elmers glue sticks</li> <li>● 1 box washable markers (classic colors)</li> <li>● 2 sturdy 2-pocket folders</li> <li>● 1 pair indoor tennis shoes (preferably with white or light gray soles)</li> <li>● 1 full size, sturdy backpack (no wheels) that is large enough to fit folder, snack, and snow pants.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>2nd Grade &amp; 2nd/3rd Grade Split</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Twenty <b>#2 pencils</b> (sharpened)</li> <li>● A box of crayons (24 count or more)</li> <li>● Small box of colored pencils</li> <li>● A sturdy folder to transport papers back and forth to school</li> <li>● A sturdy pencil box</li> <li>● Two large pink erasers</li> <li>● Four glue sticks</li> <li>● A backpack</li> <li>● 8-pack classic color markers</li> <li>● A pair of scissors (age appropriate)</li> <li>● One pair of shoes to stay at school for "indoor shoes" and a pair of tennis shoes for P.E. Each child must have a pair of "outdoor shoes" also</li> <li>● A set of headphones that fit your child (to be kept at school for computer class)</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>4th Grade</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 6 pocket folders (solid colored – red, yellow, blue, green, purple and orange)</li> <li>● 1 plastic folder to go back and forth from school to home</li> <li>● 1 folder of student's choice</li> <li>● 1 composition notebook (9.5"x7.5")</li> <li>● 1 package of wide-ruled notebook paper</li> <li>● 24 -No. 2 pencils</li> <li>● 2 glues sticks (prefer Elmer's brand)</li> <li>● Pencil box</li> <li>● 1 set of earbuds for computer/iPad use (to keep at school)</li> <li>● TI-15 or TI-30 solar calculator (Texas Instruments)</li> <li>● Inside shoes (white or light gray soles preferred)</li> <li>● Markers (optional if your child enjoys using them to color)</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Middle School</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 3" Binder used for all subjects for all 3 middle school years <b>(see below for color)</b></li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"> <b>Class of 2018: Blue</b>  <b>Class of 2019: Green</b>  <b>Class of 2020: Orange or Red</b> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Dividers – recommend plastic instead of paper</li> <li>● Scissors, markers, and pens (red and blue), and MANY #2 pencils</li> <li>● A set of earbuds that fit your child and be kept at school</li> <li>● Loose leaf paper (college ruled)</li> <li>● P.E. shoes that do not have black soles</li> <li>● P.E. shorts and shirt that meet dress code</li> <li>● NIV Bible – the one given to students in 3rd grade or when they enrolled</li> <li>● TI-30XIIS solar scientific calculator – from 4<sup>th</sup> grade, current calculators are kept at school.</li> <li>● No flash drives</li> <li>● Sports physicals required before participation in sports; must be completed after April 15 of prior year</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Kindergarten</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Put child's first name and last initial on these items:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 1 pair of indoor tennis shoes to stay at school (with Velcro unless student can tie own shoes)</li> <li>● Bath or beach towel for rest time</li> <li>● 1 full size, sturdy backpack (no wheels) that is large enough to fit folder, lunch box, and snow pants.</li> <li>● 2-3 recent pictures of your child (include name on back of each)</li> <li>● A 1" 3-ring binder</li> <li>● 1 wide-ruled bound notebook</li> <li>● 1 set of headphones that fit child (no earbuds, please)</li> <li>● "Helpful Homework" interview (sent out just before school starts)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Do not put child's name on these items:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 1 box of 20+ count crayons</li> <li>● A pair of scissors</li> <li>● 10-16 <b>No. 2</b> sharpened pencils</li> <li>● 6-10 glue sticks</li> <li>● 1 package 8-16 Classic Color markers</li> <li>● One old sock to use as white board eraser</li> <li>● 2 pink erasers</li> </ul>
