HELPFUL REMINDERS:

- Register early! Camps fill up quickly.
- A confirmation letter will be emailed after the registration is processed. The email includes important camper information. Please provide an active email address in your registration. This is the primary way we will communicate with you leading up to camp.

CANCELED AND TRANSFERRED REGISTRATIONS

All requests to change camps or to cancel registration are subject to an administrative fee of \$20 after May 1st. You will receive a full refund, minus the administrative fee, for cancellations up to 16 days before the camp's start date. Fifty percent refunds, minus the administrative fee, will be granted for cancellations 15 days or less before the camp's start date. There is no refund for no-shows except in cases of illness, injury or a death in the family.

FAQs

How soon should I register?

The sooner the better. Camps fill early and fast. All registrations are processed on a first-come basis. You must register before May 1 to get the early bird price.

Are funds available for campers needing financial assistance?

About 95 percent of camp scholarships come from the local churches. Camp Horizon has a limited amount of donated funds designated for camp scholarships. To apply for the Camp Horizon Scholarship, download the application online.

Do I have to register online?

No you can also register by phone, call the camp office to sign up.

Do I register for the grade I finished or for the I'm grade going in to.

Camps are organized by age groups based on the grade you are going in to.

How do I know my camper is registered?

You will receive registration confirmation via email confirming your camper is registered. If you have started a registration and have not received your confirmation, your camper's registration is not yet completed and not guaranteed a spot.
