## Things to Think About When You Read Luke and Acts

As you read through Luke and Acts, try thinking about at least a few of these questions. If you're reading with someone else, they might also spark some interesting conversation. (The questions are adapted from One to One Bible Reading: a Simple Guide for Every Christian by David Helm.)

### Context:

1. What has happened so far in the story of Jesus and his disciples?
2. What happened just prior to the chapter you are reading?

### Observation:

3. What do you learn about the main characters in this chapter? How does the author describe them? How do they describe themselves?
4. Is time or place significant in the events that take place?
5. Is there a conflict or a high point in the chapter? What surprises are there?
6. What do you think is the main point or theme of the chapter?

### Meaning:

7. Does someone in the chapter learn something or grow in some way? What do they learn?
8. What does this chapter show you about Jesus and what he came to do?
9. How could you summarize the meaning of this passage in your own words?

### Application:

10. How does this passage challenge (or confirm) your understanding?
11. Is there an attitude or behavior you need to change?
12. What does this chapter teach you about being a follower of Jesus?
