

Heaven is bursting with the blessings God wants to rain down on us - not a drizzle, but a deluge. Hosea 6 says "Come, let us return to the LORD...Let us strive to know the LORD...He will come to us like the rain." This is the essence of getting caught in a new kind of downpour, an absolute soaking of God's spirit for your walk with Him. Does this sound like something you need? 




