What We're Learning

We have been learning about the early church. Here is what we will be learning this month:

12/3 The Ethiopian Official Believed (Acts 8)

The Ethiopian official knew what the Old Testament prophets had said, but he did not understand that the prophets spoke about Jesus. The Holy Spirit led Philip to help the official understand the good news about Jesus: Jesus died on the cross for our sins and was raised from the dead, just like the Old Testament prophets said.

12/10 Christmas: Angels Spoke to Mary and Joseph (Luke 1, Matthew 1)

The baby Jesus fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy, as well as other Old Testament prophecies, about the coming Savior. Through His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus fulfilled God's plan of redemption that God planned before the world began.

12/17 Christmas: Jesus Was Born (Luke 2)

The birth of Jesus was good news! Jesus was not an ordinary baby. He was God's Son, sent to earth from heaven. Jesus came into the world to save people from their sins and to be their King.

12/24 Christmas:

*Toddler/Pre-School - Jesus' Birth
K-5th- Christmas Traditions*

12/31 Peter Visited Cornelius (Acts 10)

God showed Peter that just as there is no "clean" and "unclean" food, there are no "clean" and "unclean" people. God calls believers to tell everyone the good news about Jesus, no matter who they are or where they come from. Jesus is the Lord of all.
