What To Bring:

- (Please label everything—including bedding—that you bring.)
- Bed roll: sleeping bag and/or sheets, blanket, and pillow
- Towels: one for showers, and one for the pool
- Toiletries: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
- Clothing for recreation (Total of 4 days)
- Daily change of casual clothes
- Light jacket depending on the weather
- Comfortable shoes (Tennis shoes are required for recreation)
- Water shoes/flip flops for the lake (if you desire)
- Bathing suit and cover-up. A dark t-shirt must be worn over two-piece swimming suits. Boys, no "speedos."
- Spending money for the snacks and souvenirs (if you desire)
 - You may also bring your own snacks.
- Water Bottle
- Bug Spray
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Bible (we'll provide if you don't have one), and a pen
- Optional:
 - Skateboard, helmet and pads (Falls Creek provides pads if needed)
 - Sports equipment: Softball glove, volleyball, basketball, etc.

What NOT To Bring:

- Shaving cream, balloons, water guns, fireworks, tobacco
- Any inappropriate attire (See Falls Creek dress code)

Electronics

You may bring electronics for use ONLY on the ride to and from camp. A



sponsor will keep the electronics once we get to camp. Therefore please limit the number of electronics you bring to camp. Parents may contact their students by calling pastor Mason.

Falls Creek Dress Code:

While on Falls Creek grounds campers may not wear apparel that exposes the midriff, is extremely tight fitting or has writing on the back of pants or shorts. Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances or inappropriate language or pictures. All shorts and dresses should be a modest length. At Falls Creek, modest shorts are generally defined as shorts that have at least a five inch inseam or longer and dresses and skirts should be four inches from the top of the knee or longer. Slits in dresses and skirts should also be modest in length. Straps for shirts/tops must have at least three inches across the shoulder. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times outside cabins, except while swimming.

Swimming Information:

- As weather permits, swimming will be available for all campers each afternoon during recreation time.
- While going to and from the swimming areas all campers must wear shoes; boys must wear a t-shirt, and girls must wear a cover-up over their swimming suits.
- Modest swimming suits are appropriate while swimming. A dark t-shirt must be worn over two-piece swimming suits. Men should not wear tight fitting swimming suits.
- Lifeguards are responsible for safety and discipline. Anyone not observing the rules will be asked to leave the swimming area.
- There will be no running, shoving, or pushing in the swimming area.
- Each swimmer is responsible for his/her belongings. Swimmers should go directly to and from the swimming area (and not by way of the concession stands). There should be no need to carry money to the swimming area. All valuables should be left at the cabin.

I understand that it is the responsibility of my child's Host Church to obtain insurance permission for treatment or to limit my child's recreational activities because of a stated medical condition.

My child, _____ will be attending Associational Children's Camp at Falls Creek in 2017. Falls Creek Baptist Conference Center is managed and operated by the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma ("BGCO"). In the event that my child should need emergency medical care or attention, the Host Church leadership, the Associational Children's Camp, the BGCO or any of their agents or employees are hereby authorized to consent to the provision of such emergency medical care, including without limitation, medical, dental, surgical care or hospitalization, to my child as is recommended or suggested by a physician, nurse, surgeon or other health care professional.

If such emergency care is provided to my child, I understand that my child's health insurance information will be given to the health care professional and any expenses not covered by my child's insurance shall be my responsibility. I understand that the Host Church, the Associational Children's Camp or the BGCO will not be obligated to pay either the health care professional or me for any medical expenses incurred on behalf of my child.

There are instances when third party contractors are used to operate and supervise various events and activities. In those instances where third party contractors are used, I agree the Host Church, the Associational Children's Camp, and the BGCO are not responsible for the action of these third party contractors. I further agree the Host Church, the Associational Children's Camp, and the BGCO are not liable for the actions or activities of participants or sponsors participating in events or activities operated by third party contractors.

I understand that the risk of injury from any recreational activity is significant, including, but not limited to, the potential for permanent paralysis and death. While particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. I knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation in or observation of such recreational activity.

Furthermore, in consideration of my child being allowed to attend Associational Children's Camp, I, on behalf of myself and my child, hereby waive, and I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Host Church, Associational Children's Camp, the BGCO, their agents or employees, against any and all causes of action, rights, claims or suits which I or my child may have against the Host Church, Associational Children's Camp, and the BGCO, or their agents or employees as a result of injury to my child, including, but not limited to: (1) injuries arising from my child's participation in or observation of recreational activities at Falls Creek, and (2) injuries arising from the decision of the leadership of the Host Church, the Associational Children's Camp, the BGCO, or any of their agents or employees to consent to the provision of emergency medical care to my child.

I understand that my child's image may be included in a video or in photographs that may be made during camp. I understand that a promotional or highlight video may be available for sale during and after camp. I consent that my child's image may appear on videos, promotional resources, camp endorsed web sites, etc.

I give authority and permission to the Host Church, the Associational Children's Camp, and the BGCO, and any of their staff or agents to inspect my child's belongings while at Falls Creek.

I understand that Associational Children's Camp is a place where many children seek counsel and advice from adult leaders, staff, counselors and others. I hereby consent to my child receiving spiritual and emotional counsel during their week of camp.

I have received and read the Camp Packet Information (found at www.associationalchildrenscamp.com) including the list of the recreational options and the daily schedule, and I have received satisfactory answers to all my questions about such information.
