

Date: February 5, 2017 (19)

Scripture Passage: *This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.—1 John 1:5*

Lesson Theme: *Man loves darkness because His deeds are evil.*

Family Discussion Questions:

1. How can your family shed light on the darkness of abortion?
2. Perhaps you can volunteer at a crisis pregnancy center, participate in a rally, watch a pro-life video, formulate a winsome defense for pro-life policies, etc.?
3. Can you decide on something your family can do and do it together?

Date: February 12, 2017 (20)

Scripture Passage: *For the LORD, the Most High, is to be feared, a great king over all the earth.—Psalm 47:2*

Lesson Theme: *God is The Most High; He is greater than anyone or anything else.*

Family Discussion Questions:

1. What do you love most of all?
2. What is most important to you?
3. What is the first thing that you think of when you get up in the morning? Pray and ask God what is “most high” in your heart.

Date: February 19, 2017 (21)

Scripture Passage: *Encourage your child to review his or her memory verses.*

Lesson Theme: *This is a review week.*

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How has knowing the Hebrew names of God changed how you think about God?
- 2) What is your favorite Hebrew name of God? Write about it below.
- 3) Ask God to open your eyes and heart to the glorious magnitude and depth of His nature, and to give you a heart to worship Him.



Date: February 26, 2017 (22)

Scripture Passage: *There is none like you, O LORD; you are great, and your name is great in might.*
—Jeremiah 10:6

Lesson Theme: *God's many names each reveal something of His character.*

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Share with someone about one of the names you learned this week and how God is like that name.
- 2) Tell about one time this week when you saw one of God's names in action.
- 3) Research some other names of God.
