

**Date:** July 2, 2017 (38)

**Scripture Passage:** *For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.* 2 Corinthians 5:21

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus came to establish a new covenant between God and His sinful people.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 5:21 and then Romans 6:23. Why is eternal life through Jesus a gift?
- 2) Is this gift yours?
- 3) How can it be yours? Read and discuss John 3:16-18?

**Date:** July 9, 2017 (39)

**Scripture Passage:** *Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live.* John 11:25

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus' resurrection is proof that the new covenant has been fulfilled and accomplishes what it promises.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Why is it difficult for some people to believe Jesus is now in heaven reigning as King?
- 2) What do you see in the world and your own life that make this hard to understand and believe?
- 3) Read and discuss Romans 8:18-25. What "groaning" do we see? Should this surprise us? Does God know about it? Is it part of His plan?

**Date:** July 16, 2017 (40)

**Scripture Passage:** *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.* Romans 3:23

**Lesson Theme:** God desires to save sinners through what Jesus has done on the cross.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Who do you believe Jesus is?
- 2) Are you depending on Him to forgive all your sins and make you right with God?
- 3) Do you believe with all your heart that He will give you eternal life in heaven?
