

**Date:** June 4, 2017 (33)

**Scripture Passage:** *To whom then will you compare me, that I should be like him? says the Holy One.*  
—Isaiah 40:25

**Lesson Theme:** God is like nothing else. He is perfect and is separate from sin.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) How should we respond to the holy God?
- 2) What's the only thing that can make us "clean" before a holy God?
- 3) What kinds of things has God given His people to help them be holy?

**Date:** June 11, 2017 (34)

**Scripture Passage:** *Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord.* —Philippians 3:8a

**Lesson Theme:** God is most valuable and deserves our greatest love, obedience, and worship.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Do you ever act in ways that show that something is more worthy of your love, obedience, and worship than God?
- 2) What can help us to always remember that God is most valuable and deserves our greatest love, obedience, and worship?
- 3) What would a right heart response be to recognizing that God is loving? Almighty? Provider? Deliverer? etc.?

**Date:** June 18, 2017 (35)

**Scripture Passage:** *I will sing to the LORD, because he has dealt bountifully with me.* —Psalm 13:6

**Lesson Theme:** God is more than enough to satisfy all our desires.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Why might we sometimes feel like God is stingy?
- 2) Does the fact that God is bountiful mean He will always give us more of everything we want?
- 3) What kinds of things do we need most?

**Date:** June 25, 2017 (36)

**Scripture Passage:** *...The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary;...* —Isaiah 40:28b

**Lesson Theme:** God never gets tired and never sleeps.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) What might be the worst kind of tiredness a person could have?
- 2) What would make your soul tired?
- 3) What does Jesus promise you if you come to Him with this kind of tiredness?
