

Date: June 4, 2017 (34)

Scripture Passage: *And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14*

Lesson Theme: Jesus is fully God and became fully human.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What did Jesus use as a “weapon” to defeat the devil?
- 2) Have you ever used God’s Word to keep you from sinning in a certain situation?
- 3) Can you give an example of a verse that has helped you? Are you ALWAYS successful? Why not?

Date: June 11, 2017 (35)

Scripture Passage: *(John bore witness about him, and cried out, “This was he of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.’”) John 1:15*

Lesson Theme: Jesus is God’s Anointed One, the Messiah.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Why was Jesus able to interpret and explain Old Testament Scriptures?
- 2) Why did Jesus wait until after His resurrection to more fully explain how the Old Testament pointed to Him?
- 3) Does it matter whether or not you believe that everything Jesus said is true?

Date: June 18, 2017 (36)

Scripture Passage: *For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. John 1:16*

Lesson Theme: Jesus is our great High Priest, the one Mediator between God and sinful man.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How is having Jesus as our “temple” good news?
- 2) If you want to pray to God in the middle of the night, do you need to go to some special place? Why not?
- 3) Do you need to travel to a certain place to be forgiven for your sins? Why not?

Date: June 25, 2017 (37)

Scripture Passage: *For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:17*

Lesson Theme: Jesus’ death fulfilled the Old Testament promises.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How was the sacrifice Jesus offered different from any other?
- 2) Why was it necessary for Jesus to offer Himself?
- 3) Why was Jesus the perfect substitute for sinners?
