

**Date:** June 4, 2017 (33)

**Scripture Passage:** *...but God shows his love for us that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*  
—Romans 5:8

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus displays the greatness and worth of God.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Why would Jesus plan to have something very sad and painful happen to Himself?
- 2) What should sinners do when they see how much Jesus' loves them?
- 3) What should you do?

**Date:** June 11, 2017 (34)

**Scripture Passage:** *He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness.* —1 Peter 2:24a

**Lesson Theme:** All people are unrighteous sinners, except Jesus.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) How is taking away sin different from covering sin?
- 2) What does it mean that Jesus “bore our sins”?
- 3) What is one thing you could do this week to “die to sin and live to righteousness”?

**Date:** June 18, 2017 (35)

**Scripture Passage** *Jesus said..., “I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live,”* —John 11:25

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus satisfied God's righteousness when He paid the full penalty for sin.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) What is the promise that Jesus gives in this verse?
- 2) Who is the promise for?
- 3) What does it mean to believe in Jesus?

**Date:** June 25, 2017 (36)

**Scripture Passage:** *[Jesus said,] In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?*—John 14:2

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus keeps all of His promises.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Does it make you happy or sad that Jesus isn't on earth right now?
- 2) Who did Jesus send to be with His friends?
- 3) Do you want to see Jesus and be with Him forever?
