Scripture Passage: Review

Lesson Theme: Your child will review over the past several week what they have learned.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What is one verse that you remember
- 2) What is one story that you remember?
- 3) How are you different?

Date: October 8, 2017 (7)

Scripture Passage *For I will proclaim the name of the LORD; ascribe greatness to our God! The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is he. — Deuteronomy 32:3-4*

Lesson Theme: All God's purposes are right..

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Ask your child to define the following words: proclaim, ascribe, justice, iniquity, upright.
- 2) How would you explain Deuteronomy 32:3-4 in your own words?
- 3) Have your child explain to you why all God's purposes are always right

Date: October 15, 2017 (8)

Scripture Passage: *...I am God, and there is none like me, 10declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, "My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose." —Isaiah 46:9b-10*

Lesson Theme: God will accomplish all His purposes.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Read Isaiah 46:9b-10 in a few different translations of the Bible. Instruct your son or daughter to list some characteristics of God that show there really is "none" like God. What does "declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done" mean?
- 2) Working together, think of some of the declarations of God in His Word and how God brought them about.
- 3) Read and discuss Esther 4:12-14.



Date: October 22, 2017 (9)

Scripture Passage: Great is our Lord, and abundant in power; his understanding is beyond measure. —Psalm 147:5

Lesson Theme: God is never surprised; He foresees all things.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) As a team with your child, try to think of as many verses or stories in the Bible as you can that show God knows about things before they happen.
- 2) Why should this be a comfort to us?
- 3) Read John 13:21-38. Record all the places where you see Jesus' foreknowledge. How does Jesus' foreknowledge show the greatness of His love that sent Him to the cross?

Date: October 29, 2017 (10)

Scripture Passage: *For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.* —Isaiah 55:8-9

Lesson Theme: God's providential works are often hidden from man.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Read Ephesians 3:8-11
- 2) Ask your son or daughter the following questions: Who is talking?, What does he mean by "the unsearchable riches of Christ"?, What is the "plan of the mystery hidden for ages"?, Why was it hidden for ages?, How was this mystery brought to light?, How long did it take for the mystery to be brought to light?
- 3) Discuss the challenge of trusting God when His purposes are hidden and it seems that He is not working.
