Date: October 8, 2017

Scripture Passage: James 4:13-16; Matthew 16:21-23; Galatians 2:19-20; Colossians 3:3

Date: October 15, 2017

Scripture Passage: Revelation 19:11-16; Luke 8:19-21; 9:23; John 14:15-17

Lesson Theme: God delights when hearts respond to grace in surrender. Jesus deserves, loves, and commands obedience to Him. Blessings come to those who walk with Jesus and seek Him first.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) In what ways do you struggle to obey God?
- 2) How should you respond to the Holy Spirit in your life?
- 3) How can you apply this lesson in your life this week?

Date: October 22, 2017

Scripture Passage: John 6:38; John 17:6-10; Matthew 26:36-42; Hebrews 12:1-3

Lesson Theme: Jesus is the perfect example of how to live a life surrendered to God's perfect will. Jesus understand God's authority in His life and sought to have a relationship with Him. God loves us, pursues us, and strengthens us.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What is keeping you from walking in obedience to God?
- 2) Who can you reach out to that is going through a hard time and offer God's love?
- 3) What do you think God's will is for your life right now?

Date: October 29, 2017

Scripture Passage: Ephesians 4:17-24; Psalm 86:11; Psalm 32:8-9; Numbers 11:21-23

Lesson Theme: Because Christians find their home in God, we must submit our mind, heart, and will to Him. God's ways are far above our ways, so we must seek His word to know His way. We must be humble and teachable before the Lord.
