# JEWISH OUTREACH

Today is the Jewish Feast of First Fruits, the feast that always pictured the resurrection of Messiah and His lifting up to the Father. On this day, grain farmers would bring in the first cuttings of the winter crops—winter wheat, rye and barley. This Thank-Offering sheaf would be taken into the Temple area to the priest, who lifted up and waved it before the Lord, in gratitude to God for a great crop. Twice in 1 Cor. 15, Paul refers to Messiah as the firstfruits offering. As our Great High Priest, He was on His way to present Himself to the Father as First Fruits offering, when He told the ladies, "Touch me not, for I have not yet ascended to my Father." Later that evening, because He had finished the offering of Himself and come back, His invitation to the disciples was, "Touch me." If you have not yet mailed a Passover card to your Jewish friends, please do so immediately. It's not too late. If God gives you an opportunity, share with them about the third feast fulfilled during Holy Week—the Feast of First Fruits.
