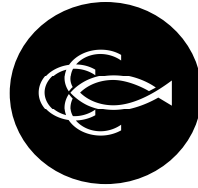
Large print bulletins for our morning worship are available in the Information Center.

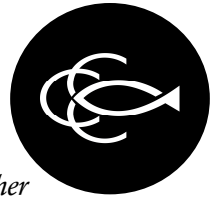
