Small Group Questions:

- 1. What was your favorite memory from Small Group this year? Why is that your favorite memory?
- 2. What was your favorite Big Group talk from this year? Why was it your favorite?
- 3. What was a discussion that you either didn't like or didn't understand? What didn't you like or understand?
- 4. What do we know to be True because of the things we studied this year? (Subcategories were: Truths about God, Truths About Man, Relevant Transformation, On Mission)
- 5. Is Truth sometimes hard to hear? Is it still true even if we don't want to hear it?

- 6. Why do you think God tells us truths that aren't easy or fun to hear? (because He loves us and wants us to know truth instead of lies)
- 7. What are we supposed to do with truth? (Act on it, live it out)
- 8. What are some ways that you are going to live out Truth this Summer?
- 9. How do we want to keep in touch this Summer?
- 10. How can we be praying for each other over the Summer?

But be sure to let your students own the discussion. Help them see and unpack the hard things of this year as well as remember and celebrate the Wins of this year. \odot
