About 15 years ago I was listening to a recording of Erwin McManus, and I was challenged to consider what my core values are. Not simply nice things to aspire to if I felt like it on any given day, but the non-negotiables of life.

So, in the months and even years that followed I started to reflect on, and map out what my core values might be. I took the time to consider how my faith in Jesus affected these values, and would I be prepared to pay the price if these values were challenged.

They started as values, which over time were refined and tweaked. They were discussed with key people in my life and were then given time to rest and prove themselves. When challenged, I would go back to them and consider if they were too restrictive, was I too dogmatic. Then after a few years of prayerful consideration, they moved from being just values to core values.

These have become values that I have shared with various people and ministry contexts. When facing difficult situations, my core values have brought clarity and confidence to make and stand by decisions – even when that has resulted in my concluding employment.

Have you ever stopped to consider what the non-negotiables or core values might be for you?
