Pastor's Message

Change . . . in the church!?

Have no fear, brothers and sisters! I'm not talking about changes in theology or changes in worship or changes even in carpet color or scheduled programs. However, I do want to write this month and highlight a few of the changes that are happening around First ARP. And I think that they represent the hard work and dedication of our leadership and members.

One of the biggest changes that is beginning to happen was featured in <u>last month's newsletter</u>: *our capital improvements*. During these summer months, you will see ongoing repairs and improvements all around our church, from gym renovation to HVAC work to bathroom remodeling. Our leadership has worked tremendously hard to provide a good path forward for this work, and I commend them! Let us rejoice in God's faithfulness to take care of His people and to provide for our work, here at FARP.

Beyond this, however, I'd like to highlight a few of the other changes or improvements that you've begun to see around the church. One of the big ones is a complete upgrade and overhaul to our sanctuary audio and video equipment, though you may not see it unless you receive our service recordings or subscribe to our sermon podcast. And through God's goodness, a generous benefactor has provided for all of these upgrades at no cost to the church! We now have reliable overflow available anywhere in the church. We upgraded the assisted listening devices for any who may need help hearing during our services (available at the sound cabinet). We have completely redone our video feed with a sharp and clear picture to benefit those homebound members who receive recordings of our service. And did I mention . . . we have podcasts of our sermons so that you can enjoy them, even if you are out of town . . . and from anywhere! (available for: iTunes/Android)

Another important update is our website (firstarp.org). If you have not visited the site in a while, then I encourage you to spend some time browsing around! You'll find helpful links to everything from what we believe to our leadership makeup to what we believe about public worship to sermon archives to VBS registration to online giving opportunities to all the ways in which we are connected.

We have also been trying to update and improve our communication across all areas of our church life. We have a newly revamped digital newsletter that allows us to better connect our ministries. We are continuing to connect and resource our ministries so that our leadership can equip the saints [that's all of us] for the work of ministry (Eph. 4:12). Mission News



Mission Update from Michael & Laura Cochran

These past several months have brought lots of changes for our missionary journey, and we are excited to share with you about all the ways the Lord is working in our lives! Late last year the board of World Witness approved a field change for us from Spain to the United Kingdom. During the last several years, the Lord has raised up six

families who are faithfully serving in Spain, and it became clear that He was calling us to serve elsewhere. We are thrilled to share about the growing partnership between the ARP Church and the Evangelical Presbyterian Church in England and Wales (EPCEW), a small British denomination with a big vision for the Gospel in the UK. It is our great privilege to work alongside EPCEW to see new churches planted in England and Wales.

Initially we will be serving at Naunton Lane Presbyterian Church in Cheltenham, England, where Michael will have the opportunity to preach, teach, and minister in a British context and be mentored by the pastor and elders there. After a period of training, we will work with EPCEW to determine a location to begin the work of church planting. We are amazed at the opportunities the Lord has placed before us, and we are encouraged and excited about the work that is going on in the UK and how we will get to be a part of it.

We recently completed four weeks of cross-cultural missions training, which was a wonderful time of preparation. By the Lord's grace, we have raised 94% of our needed support, which means we need only \$415 more a month in pledged support to leave for the field! Please pray that the Lord would raise up our remaining monthly support quickly so that we can begin the visa process. We are aiming to be on the field, Lord willing, by the end of the summer! Thank you for your prayers and the support of your church. We are so grateful for your partnership as we work to expand the Kingdom of God in England and Wales!

Mission Team Prayer Partners

Prayer is the most essential preparation for each of us as we seek to do God's work, at home or abroad. As we prepare to send mission teams this summer to Appalachia, the Palmer Home for Children, and Spain, we want each short term missionary to be paired with a "Prayer Partner." This partner is someone who will pray for them now while they are planning and preparing, and daily while they are on the mission trip.


