



Piedmont is partnering with several churches in the Metro-ATL area and Central GA for an awesome week-long camp at the Laguna Beach Christian Retreat in PCB, FL. This will be a week that your student will remember for the rest of his/her life! We will leave Sunday afternoon on June 19 and return Friday afternoon on June 24th. The cost for the trip will increase as the departure date gets closer.

- If you pay your \$100 deposit by 12/31/15, your total cost of the trip will be \$295 (\$100 discount)
- If you pay your \$100 deposit by 2/21/16, your total cost of the trip will be \$345 (\$50 discount)
- If you pay your \$100 deposit by 5/27/16, your total cost of the trip will be \$370 (\$25 discount)
- After 5/27/16, total cost of the trip is \$395 and we will only accept applicants as space is available.

**All monies must be paid for by 6/1/2016**

All meals (except for travel meals and 1 dinner out) will be covered. Students may want to bring money for shopping (or starbucks) and any merchandise from the band or camp.

## **Limited Space Available:**

We have a maximum of 30 spaces available. Once those spots are full we will start a reserve list. This list will be treated similarly to the 30 spots, except for their money will be returned if they do not receive a spot. If someone drops before the 5/27/16 date their money will be returned and the next person on the reserve list will occupy that spot

## **Free Time/Beach Time:**

We will have a student/leader ratio of 1 leader to every 5 students. Students will be placed into a 'buddy' system, all 'buddies' will be together at all times while they are at the beach and/or pool and will be required to check in with a leader hourly. Students will not go anywhere alone! They must be with their 'buddies' at all times.

Our 'in water' policy - No student is allowed in the ocean without an adult with them at all times. Rules for the pool: students cannot be at the pool without an adult, an adult does not have to be in the water with them, but they must accompany them to the pool area.
