



To the congregation of Fifth Avenue Baptist:

The Personnel Committee has interviewed a candidate for the Associate Minister of Education position and voted unanimously to extend a call to the candidate. This action was approved by Church Council and recommended to the Church. The candidate was brought forward to the Personnel Committee by the process of the Pastoral Search Committee. The candidate's resume was fully reviewed and recommendations were gathered to support it. The role of Associate Minister of Education is covered by a specific job description that includes duties such as leadership, teaching, and preaching. The prospective candidate will be fulfilling all these roles.

This calling is associated with the calling and acceptance of the Pastor and will be considered at the same time as the calling of the Pastor in the vote by the church.

There will be an opportunity to meet the prospective Associate Minister of Education during the Pastor Visitation weekend which will begin on Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup> and continue through worship on Sunday, June 26<sup>th</sup>. Multiple opportunities will be provided throughout that weekend for you to discuss the vision of adult education for Fifth Avenue Baptist Church.
