Deadlines for Early Re-Application & Registration Discounts

All students need to reapply for the 2017 – 2018 school year. The fee is \$160 per student. However, if you reapply on or before Tuesday, **February 28**th, there is a \$50 <u>early reapplication discount</u> per student; only accounts in good standing may receive this discount.

The deadline for the early registration discount is Friday, April 28th. The registration fee is \$460 per student, and the <u>early registration discount</u> is \$50 per student. To qualify for the early registration discount: 1) the student must have already reapplied; 2) the student's account needs to be in good standing; and 3) the registration payment must be received by April 28, 2017. We are currently working with RenWeb to provide on-line registration; Mrs. Welch will email you on how to complete the on-line application & registration, these instructions will be emailed as soon as we receive them from Renweb.
